RESAK ISLAMIC DAY BY KTDI CULTIVATE THE NATURE OF AD-DEEN (REID)

(CULTURE)

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From 12th till 14th March 2020, Jawatankuasa Kolej Mahasiswa (JKM) Kolej Tun Dr. Ismail (KTDI) had successfully held a program called Resak Islamic Day 2020 or better known as REID'20. ReID'20 program provided a platform for all levels of students and community who wanted to cultivate and strengthen the nature of "*Ad-deen*" as well as hone the talents hidden in each individual.

This seminar was also an Islamic event that was open to people of other religions too.
