## **Justification in Joining Activities**

In October 2020, I had been planned to organize program as all members of PERSAKA committee must do to gain the leadership skills along the process of organizing event. In 9 November 2020, I created the group and making the proposal of program on what the program should be in the future. ## **The Graduate Attributes that are focused on**

This event has focused on three Graduate Success Attributes which are the Communication Skills, Leadership Skills and Adaptability Skills.

In the event, one of the Graduate Attributes that was focused on was the communication skills, especially the “**communication skills**” in the Virtual Delegation committee. Be a leader or director of program we need to communicate a lot of people and need to give clear explanation during the proposal meeting and always keep it touch of all progresses from all small units under Creative'20. The most important when be a leader make sure our words is polite but still can make people to do on what we ask, don't harsh everyone in our team as it will make the connection of relationship become poor.

The event has also trained the “**leadership and team working**” skill of each committee member.
