In year 2020, we have the COVID-19 outbreak all around the world, we are required to adapt and innovate our project during the planning phase into a Virtual Volunteering Exchange, where we run our project virtually. To ensure the quality of the projects and also the wellbeing of the volunteers, we have to constantly do a "one-to-one" session every week where each of the OC will go into one – to – one space to understand how is the volunteer doing and provide them challenge and motivates them.
