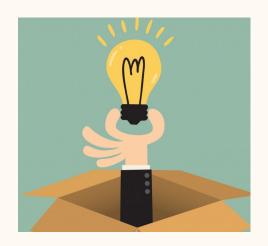






CREATIVE AND CRITICAL THINKING

HOW TO BE A CREATIVE AND

CRITICAL THINKER?

Ways to improve creative thinking

1. Be a lifelong learner

Experience and knowledge are important components to spark one's creativity. Individuals can continuously learn from their own feelings, imagination, experiences and their environment.

2. Take constructive criticism graciously

Learn to stop reacting emotionally when given any criticism as it helps in triggering a new direction of thinking.

3. Do the "no bad idea" brainstorming activities

Bring up a formal or non-formal topic to the brainstorming. It is important to make sure there are no negative comments on each other idea proposed.



In simple words, first principles thinking method or "reasoning form first principle" is basically the practice of actively questioning every assumption you think about a given problem or scenario so that complicated problems are broken down into basic elements so that a new solution and knowledge can be created from scratch.

On the other side, reasoning by analogy is thinking and solving problems based on prior knowledge, assumptions, and beliefs that are approved by a majority of people. This thinking approach was once used by the philosopher Aristotle and is used now by Elon Musk.

"Because if you applied that reasoning to anything new, then you wouldn't be able to ever get to that new thing.... you can't say, ... "oh, nobody wants a car because horses are great, and we're used to them and they can eat grass and there's lots of grass all over the place and ... there's no gasoline that people can buy...."

Here is the **3 steps of first principles thinking** by him.

- 1. Identify and define your current problems
- 2. Breakdown the problem into its fundamental elements
- 3. Create a new solution from scratch

This is a quick example from Elon Musks about battery packs during an interview with Kevin Rose.

... they would say, "historically, it costs \$600 per kilowatt-hour. And so it's not going to be much better than that in the future. ... So the first principles would be, ... what are the material constituents of the batteries? What is the spot market value of the material constituents? ... It's got cobalt, nickel, aluminum, carbon, and some polymers for separation, and a steel can. So break that down on a material basis; if we bought that on a London Metal Exchange, what would each of these things cost? Oh, jeez, it's ... \$80 per kilowatt-hour. So, clearly, you just need to think of clever ways to take those materials and combine them into the shape of a battery cell, and you can have batteries that are much, much cheaper than anyone realizes

Setting good objectives may be an essential time management skill.

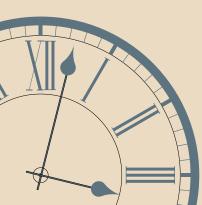

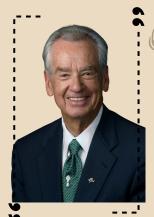
Getting Rid of Procrastiantion

How to become an Effective Communicator

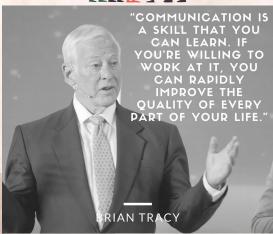
Clearly state the purpose you speak, present or asking such as to ask for opinions, to recommend people or to complaint. This can lead to the receiver to take note on the points you are talking about and clearly understand it. Hence, this would make the receiver eager to listen and focus of your talk.

Speak audibly, clearly and confidently. Use simple yet precise words when speaking and speak loudly with appropriate tone to ensure the receiver can hear and understand. Keeping an eye contact and a good body posture while talking also a sign of your confidence.

Be attentive and do not interrupt when the sender is speaking or presenting. Give the speaker your full attention without doing unnecessary gestures or actions such as tapping your legs or pens. Asking questions when the speaker done speaking or presenting and ask politely by raising your hand before asking. These actions also show how respectful you are.

Show interest when the speaker talking by giving appropriate gestures such as nodding as a sign you understand or agree the statement given. Other than that, asking open-ended questions also an indication that you are interested and focus during the discussion.
