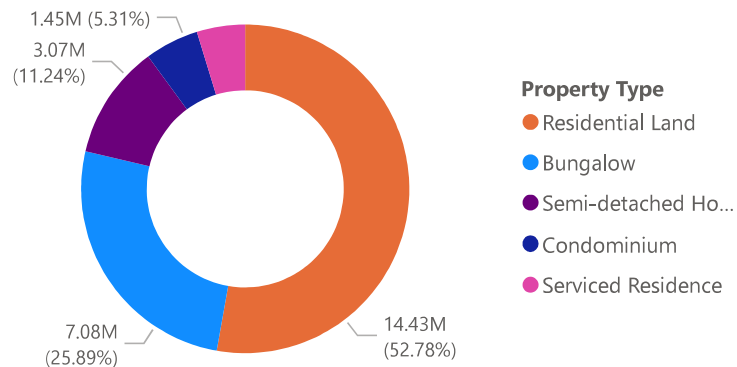


PROPERTIES PRICE & TYPES IN KUALA LUMPUR

This Donut Chart represents the average price based on property type. It represents the average price per unit of each property type.

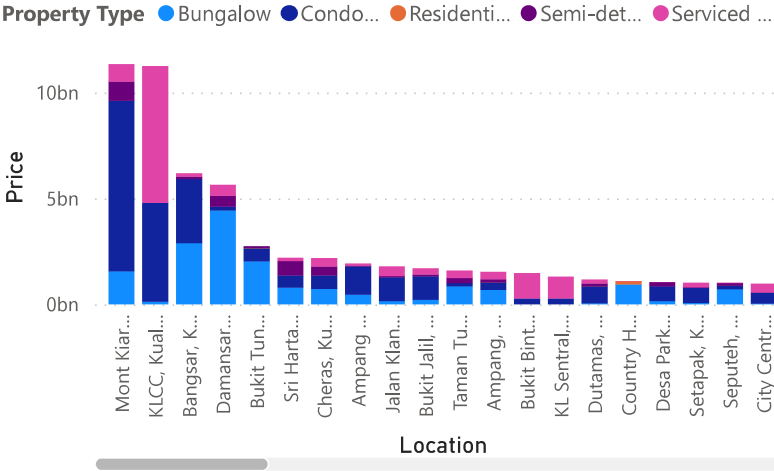

Total Price of Units (RM)

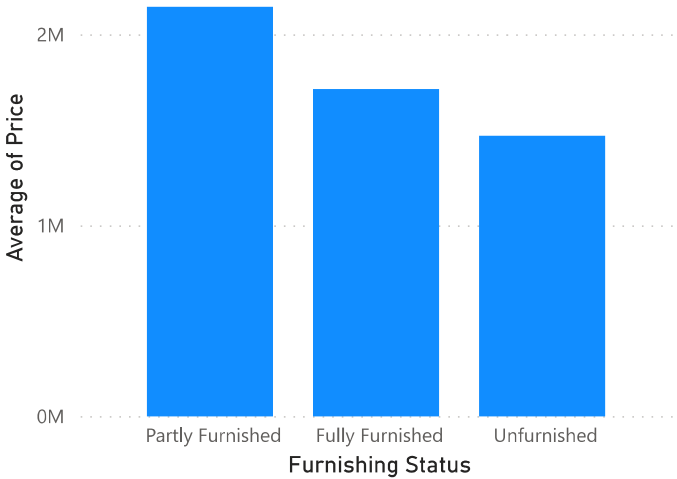
This number represent the total price of all the properties listed in the data,

Price by Location and Property Type



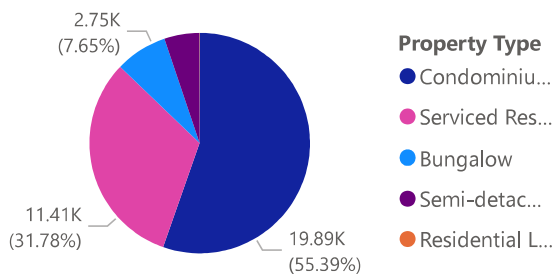

Average of Price by Furnishing Status



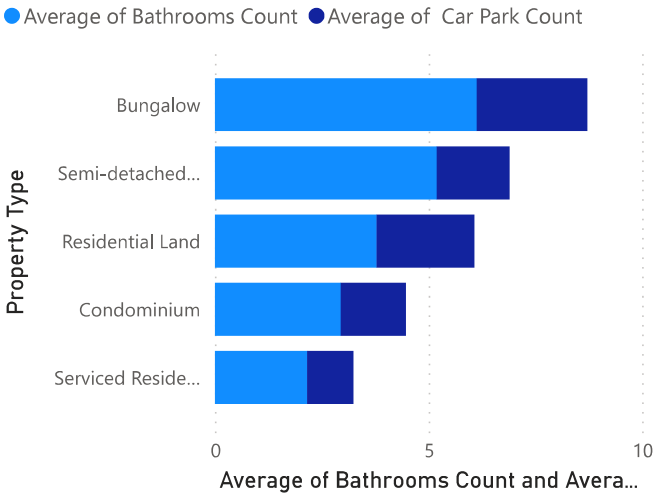
