

What kind of questions do developers ask on Stack Overflow?



To discuss and solve their development challenges, many developers utilize question and answer sites like Stack Overflow (SO). As a result, there are almost 16,000,000 varied inquiries on SO dealing with developer issues. There are almost 27,000,000 response posts for these queries. The question postings are referred to as posts in the following. The response postings are not included unless they are specifically acknowledged.

Stack Overflow only accepts programming queries that are narrowly focused on a specific issue. Questions of a more general character, or those that invite solutions that are fundamentally subjective, are frequently marked as closed by the site's users.

Closing queries is a key difference between Yahoo! Answers and other Q&A sites, as well as a measure to avoid low-quality inquiries. In 2013, the system was changed, and questions that were amended after being placed "on hold" now show in a review queue. Duplicate inquiries, according to Jeff Atwood in 2010, are not considered as an issue, but rather as an opportunity if they provide additional visitors to the site by multiplying relevant keyword hits in search engines.


