The Graduate Attribute(s)

The program aims to connect higher education with the needs of the community. By engaging in KKN, students are expected to understand more deeply the real conditions of the community, understand the various problems faced, and find solutions in accordance with their field of study. In addition, KKN also aims to increase students' social awareness and responsibility, as well as forming leadership character and independence in carrying out community service tasks.

There are three elements contained in the real work study activities namely, education, research, and community service, namely:

1. As an educational activity, through real work lectures students are introduced directly to society and its problems as well as to inter-sectoral or interdisciplinary ways of working. with inter-sectoral or interdisciplinary ways of working.
