

(a) Matric Card:

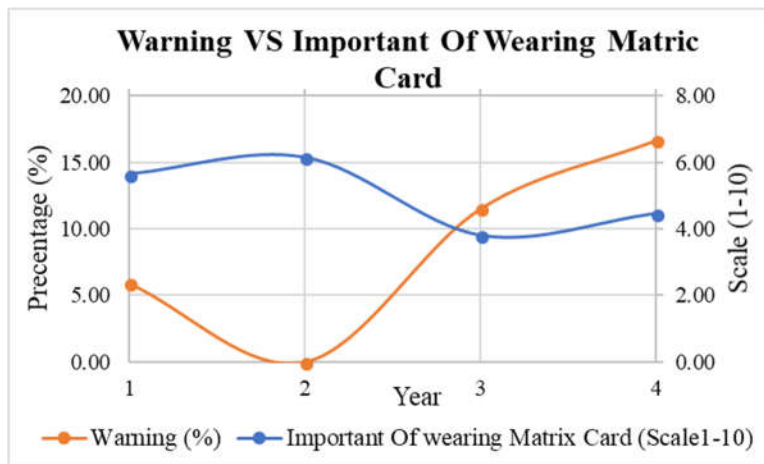


Fig. 1. Percentage of warning given to student to wear matric card versus student's opinions on important of wearing matric card by year.

Fig. 1 shows percentage of warning given to student to wear matric card versus student's opinions on important of wearing matric card by year. The percentage of warning decrease to zero from year 1 to year 2 and increase after year 2. Its is observed that when more warning given to student, student will be more likely to fell that it was not important to wear matric card. Table I shows overall percentage of warning given to students and student's opinions on important of wearing matric card. The opinion on important of wearing matric card was below average and the percentage of student who had receive warning to wear matric card was quite less, only 11.25%. It can be said that university was not emphasize on wearing matric very much.

Fig. 2. shows the frequency of wearing matric card. Most of the student (45%) only wear matric card during the first and second week to UTM. 27.5% of student said they didn't wear matric card at all and 20% of students said that they only wear matric card during exam. Surprisingly, 2.5% of students stated that they will always wear matric card whenever they were in UTM campus.

Fig. 3. shows environment that student will wear matric card. Most of the student (45%) wear matric card at exam hall. 37.5% of students said they didn't wear matric card in list of environments. The list of environments includes lecture hall, exam hall, college office, laboratory, faculty office and HEMA UTM. There was only 3.75% of student wear matric card at laboratory.

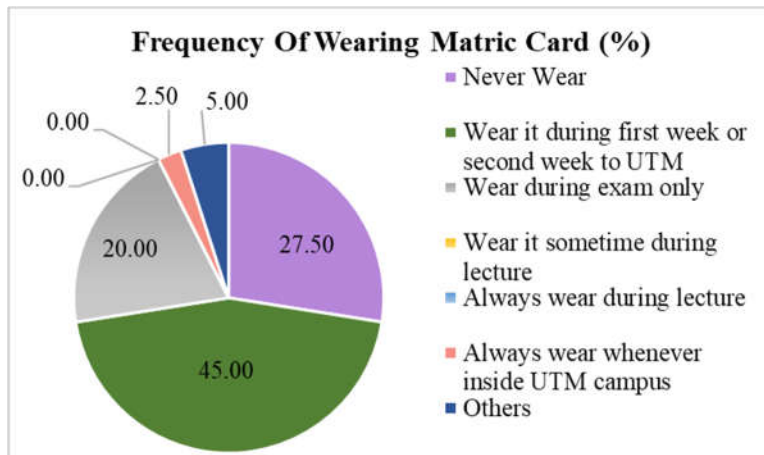


Fig. 2. Frequency of wearing matric card.

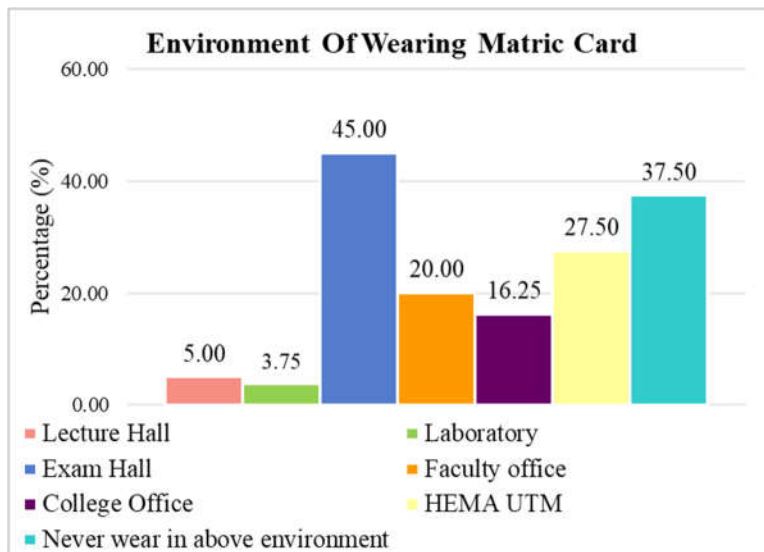


Fig. 3. Environment that student will wear matric card.
