

(b) Collared shirt

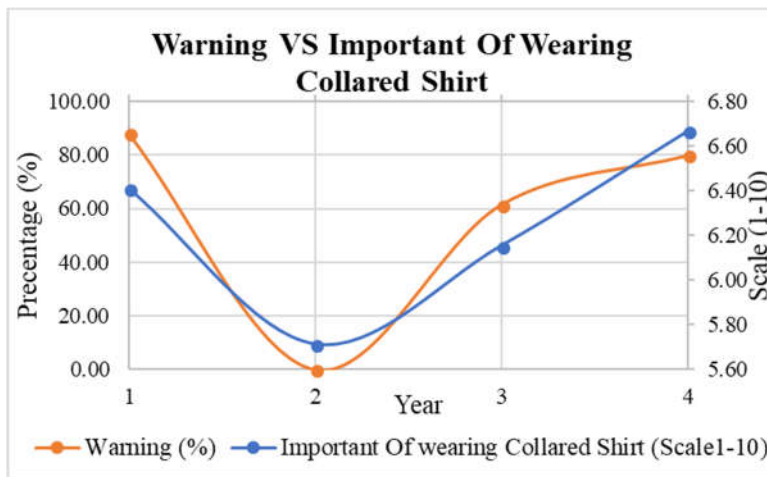


Fig. 4. Percentage of warning given to student to wear collared shirts versus student’s opinions on important of wearing collared shirt by year.

Fig.4 shows the percentage of warning given to student to wear collared shirts versus student’s opinions on important of wearing collared shirt by year. Both warning given to student and opinion on important of wearing collared shirt were lowest for year 2 students. Year 1 and year 4 student had quite similar opinions on wearing collared shirt which both were above 6.4%. It was observed that there was close relationship between warning given to student and opinion on important of wearing collared shirt. Most students feel that wearing collared shirt was important as they receive warning. Table II shows overall percentage of warning given to students and student’s opinions on important of wearing collared shirt. There were 76.25% of students said that they have ever receive warning to wear collared shirts and the average rating on important of wearing collared shirt was above average with 6.36%.

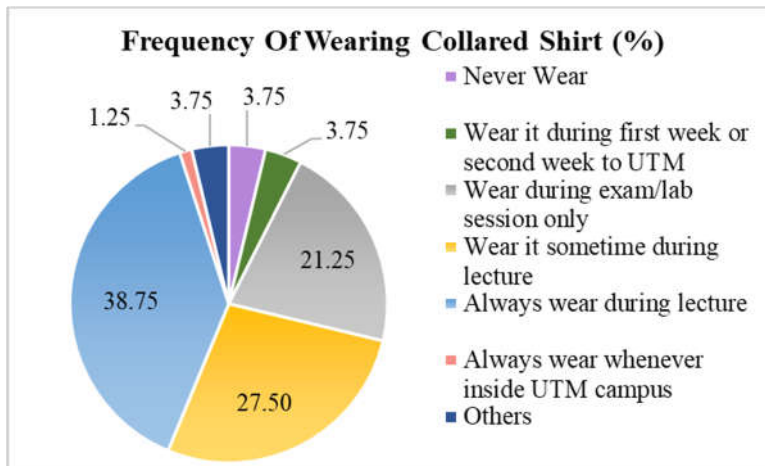


Fig. 5. Frequency of wearing collared shirt.

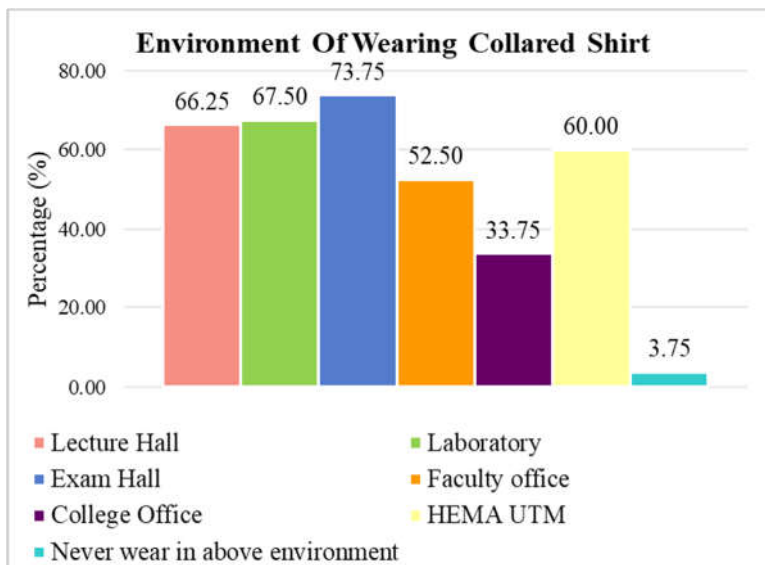


Fig. 6. Environment that student will wear collared shirt.

Fig. 5 shows frequency of wearing collared shirt. 1.25% of student said that they always wear collared shirts whenever inside UTM campus. 38.75% of students always wear it during lecture and 27.5% of student sometimes wear collared shirt during lecture. This shows that most of student were following the shirt dress code during lecture time. Fig. 6 shows environment that student will wear collared shirt. All the environment shows quite similar percentage from the range of 50% to 70% and at college office was less that was with (33.75%). Only 5% of students never wear collared shirt.
