There are several different ways we share information with one another. For example, you might use verbal communication when sharing a presentation with a group. You might use written communication when applying for a job or sending an email.











#### 1. Verbal

Verbal communication is the use of language to transfer information through speaking or sign language.










#### 2. Nonverbal

Written communication is the act of writing, typing or printing symbols like letters and numbers to convey information.




#### 4. Visual




#### **Game Number 01:Gesture**
