For Pondy's model of organizational conflict, there are 5 stages of conflict which are latent conflict, perceived conflict, felt conflict, manifest conflict and conflict aftermath. The movie that we have seen, involves conflict is "The Secret Life of Pets".

Stage 1 is latent conflict. There is no actual conflict but the potential for conflict to arise is present. Sources of conflict can cause it to suddenly or gradually emerge.

In the movie "Secret Life of Pets", a dog owner, named Katie, she has a tiny dog, Max. Max and Katie treat each other very nicely. Max is a loyal dog. One day, Katie brought back a dog, Duke that she adopted from an animal control center. Katie asked Max to be friend with Duke and get along well.

Stage 2 is perceived conflict. This stage begins when one party becomes aware that its goals are thwarted. The conflict usually escalates as functions start to argue about the origin of the problem.

Stage 3 is felt conflict. During this stage, the parties in conflict develop negative, antagonistic feelings about each other.

In the quarrel, Duke broke a vase. Max came up with an idea that he wanted to tackle Duke back aggressively. Then, Max broke many things in Katie's house. Max
