Advanced tools play an essential role to be able to maintain control over the phases in a project that are related to the scheduling and time control.

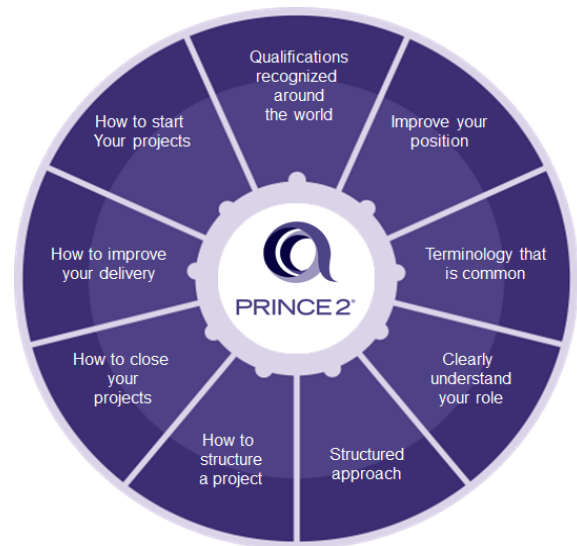


Fig. 1. The PRINCE2 elements.
