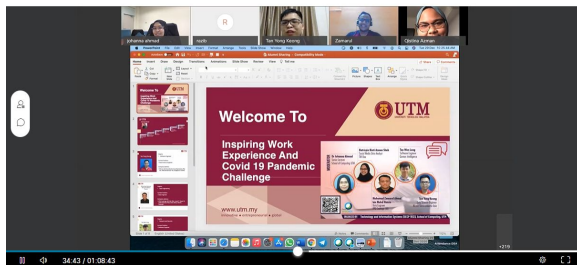


Inspiring Working Experience And Covid-19 Pandemic Challenge

The program began with a welcoming speech by Dr Johanna Ahmad as a moderator and introduction of all the speakers which are Tan Yong Keong, Mohammad Zamarul Akmal, and Qistina Batrisyia.

Tan Yong Keong or YK, who currently worked as Data Science Engineer in Micron Semiconductor Asia, Singapore shared that his own experience in pursuing his career. Since YK was in university, he was very active in participating in competitions, which helps him to gain self-confidence as well as professional skills. He also stressed that the result of the competition was not important but the experience, gained after losing or winning the competition is more valuable in the future. Hence, he encouraged the juniors to active in

joining competitions. In addition, he said that he also took freelance jobs before he got himself in current job. Through the freelance jobs, he had sharpened his skills and gained more working experiences. During the sharing session, Tan Yong Keong or YK also shared his hobbies during his leisure time. YK said that he usually will play games, or read books which are related to machine learning or Artificial Intelligence (AI). Moreover, he also shared, how he stay motivated especially during the pandemic. YK said, he always stayed positive, excite to explore new things and willing to help people by developing new program or software. At the same time, he gave some advises to the juniors, in improving programming skills. He suggested the juniors to practice more and changed their mindset to love or enjoy programming. The project is about gathering all the social media data and interpreting the data into a social media dashboard for the client to improve their company branding.

In addition, she shared some tips for being hired as a permanent employee. Firstly, be proactive. We should not wait for others to teach us in doing some job, and immediately tell others when we need guidance. Secondly, do not even limit yourself and try to learn new stuff. After that she shared that we can train our confidence, in joining some programs that need us to present something during university life.
