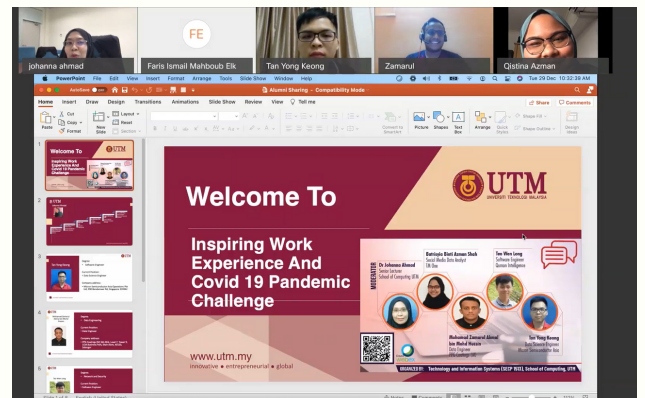


What happen in the program
