After internship, you can find your way to get a good job. Let's find out what some ex students of UTM have to say in this topic.

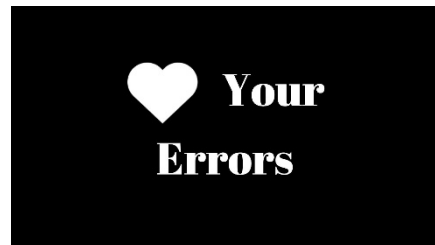

Study life VS Career life ROKNUZZAMAN RASEL

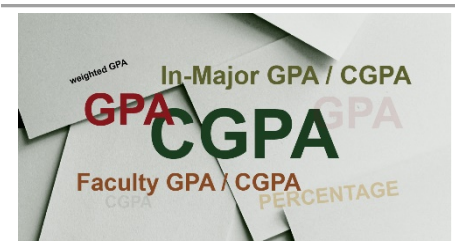
During university life you will get a lot of free time. Specially on the vacations, use those time to improve your skills. If you make any mistakes during your student life.
